

INTRODUCTION

Songbook
4.1 Greet students at the door and invite them to sit in a circle. Sing a song.

Letter "R" Poster
4.2 Show students the Letter "R" Poster. Explain to students that the activities will be about the letter R and about red things.

4.3 Read the text aloud with the music. Use classical music (Dr. Lozano's recommendations). Have students follow the reading quietly.

4.5 Choral reading: Have the students echo the teacher's reading. Vary voices.

"R" Vocabulary Cards and Poster
4.6 Show the cards that have the "R" vocabulary. Pronounce the words and invite students to pronounce them with you. Place them where students can see them and pronounce them again. Ask one of the students to show you "radio." Ask somebody else to show you another word. Make sentences about them: "The radio is small." You might even ask funny questions: "Is the radio red?" etc. Pronounce them again.

4.7 Point out other things that are "red." Invite students to pronounce the names of the items with you. Ask students to show you something "red" in the class. After they show you, put the item's name into a sentence in English: "My blouse is red." Ask students to repeat with you.

PRIMARY / SECONDARY ACTIVATIONS

4.8 Ask students to help you make a list of red things they can spot in the class. Write the list on the board. Count the items on the list in English. Then make another list. This list will consist of red items that are not in the class. Pronounce the vocabulary with the class.

Surprise Box
4.9 Tell the class that this lesson is about the color red like: flower, apple, tongue, lips, etc. Show a box filled with red objects. Pronounce the names of some of them.

Letter "R" Poster and Vocabulary cards
4.10 With your help, students in small groups match the vocabulary words in small groups.

4.11 Ask students to pronounce the vocabulary.

4.12 Have students cut out the letter "R" and glue them on their workbooks.

INTRODUCTION

Welcome
2.1 Greet students at the door.

Greetings
2.2 Ask each of them how they are. Encourage answering using complete answers.

Personal Introductions
2.3 Introduce yourself to the class (one more time) and ask each student, "What is your name?"

Professions
2.4 Review the professions vocabulary, first the pronunciations and then the meanings.

Song Book
2.5 Sing a song. Explain the vocabulary and sing again.

PRIMARY ACTIVATIONS

World Map
2.6 Show a map of the world. Talk about the countries in which most people speak English. Talk about and point to other well-known countries on the map.

2.7 Say, "I'm from _____" on the map, pointing to your country. Use cognate words, etc., while describing your country.

Ask each student: "Where are you from?" Invite each student to respond: "I am from _____." After the student responds, repeat the name of the country and make a comment about it. Point out his/her country on the poster. Invite students to share information about their countries.

Numbers
2.12 Count the students and states using the numbers poster.

Song Book
2.13 Sing and teach the children's "ABC" song to students.

Alphabet Flashcards
2.14 Present each letter of the **alphabet** again by showing and pronouncing the word printed on a card with the accompanying picture. Place the cards on the floor and pronounce one of them. Have students find the one you pronounced.

U.S.A. Puzzle
2.15 Pair students. Invite students to put together a **puzzle of the United States**. Encourage the students by looking at the appropriate poster and pronouncing the names of states while they are working on the puzzle. After finishing, have each group say aloud names of as many states as they can remember.

2.16 Sing the "ABC" song.

Alphabet
2.17 Have students complete an alphabet poster. Have students pronounce some of the cards should be...

Phonics/Vowel Cards
2.18 Pair students. Give each pair a set of cards that shows one of the vowel sounds listed on the poster and a word that contains the vowel sound. Pronounce this vocabulary with the students. Divide up the cards. Have each student pronounce his/hers to the other student.

U.S.A. Map
2.19 Have students write a few names of cities and states on their personal maps of the United States.

ABC
2.20 Have students sing the alphabet song and match the states with the letter of the alphabet.

2.21 Alphabet Soup. Divide students into teams of 3-4. Give each team a set of alphabet letter cards. Dictate words, one at a time, for students to spell with their letter cards. Encourage students to refer to posters on the wall as needed.

2.22 Students may race against each other as they go down the alphabet in order picking up the mixed-up letters from the floor. The student with the most letters wins.

Classroom Vocabulary
2.23 Give students sufficient white sheets of paper to fold and make an alphabet book. Have students provide a picture and a word for each letter. Introduce **classroom vocabulary**. Students may use dictionaries and use common vocabulary.

Long and Short Vowels
2.24 Invite students to share their books and point out some long and short vowel sounds. The students to finish first may add more words to the bottom of each page that begin with the letter.

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Talk about fun activities. Brainstorm with the class about what their family does together for fun. Take the children back in time and brainstorm about what people used to do for fun.

1.2 Divide students into groups of four. Each group is going to do a TV commercial about something to eat. The commercial should be in a family setting. One group will be a commercial for the 30's, another group for the 50's, another group for the 70's, another group for the 90's, and another group for 2010.

My Adventures Reading Book, page 4-6

1.3 Turn on classical music. Read "Picnic" in the reading text, following the music and the guidelines for the concert.

PASSIVE CONCERT

PRIMARY ACTIVATIONS

My Adventures Reading Book, Page 4-6

1.5 Read the textbook in union with the students. Ask for volunteers to read a sentence or paragraph.

1.6 Talk about picnics. Are they very common in TX? Why? What about in other parts of the country?

1.7 Talk about the reading. Ask questions to check for student understanding. Ask for volunteers to retell the story to the class. Invite students to act out the story again in their own words without the text.

Picnic Vocabulary Flashcards

1.8 Have students practice the pronunciation of the "Picnic" vocabulary after the teacher. Using only English, the teacher explains the words. (She/he can use sentences similar to the ones used in the reading.)

Spelling: Digraphs

1.9 Explain what a digraph is. Write a few on the board for students to see. Pronounce them with the class. Explain that English is a language that has many digraphs. Say a few words and ask students whether the word has a digraph or not.

Present, Past, Past Participle Flashcards

1.10 Explain what a verb is and its function within a sentence. Ask the class to give you several examples of verbs. Give the class examples of present, past and future tense. Briefly explain the differences in them. Ask for examples. Explain that verbs have three important parts: present, past and past participle. Write a few examples of each.

Irregular Past Tense Flashcards

1.11 Explain that every tense has irregular verbs, and that the past tense is not the exception. Make a list of some of the irregular past tense verbs. Pronounce them with the class. Give examples of them.

j and ch Sound

1.12 Explain what is special about the "j" and "ch" sound. First, the "j" sound. Write some words with this sound. Explain when "g" is pronounced as "j". Invite students to write some words with "j" and "ch" sounds. Then explain the difference between "j" and "ch". Students write words with these sounds.

PRIMARY / SECONDARY ACTIVATIONS

1.13 Explain the meaning of an expository text. Talk about the difference between a fact and text. Have the class brainstorm on what is needed to organize a picnic or any party. Explain the format of "mind mapping." Use it when gathering ideas for a picnic or any party. Assign different mind maps to students.

1.14 Have the class work together matching the definitions of the picnic vocabulary on p.7 of their My Adventures Reading Book.

1.15 Have students practice the spelling of the picnic vocabulary words with a partner.

1.16 Have the class make a list of common digraphs. Have students write them in their notebooks and mark the digraphs in a special color they select.

Present, Past, Past Participle Flashcards

1.17 Have students take notes in their notebooks about the three different parts of verbs. Have students write examples with each form. Using the flashcards with the different forms of the verb, have students practice them and quiz each other. With the class divided into groups of four students, make a list of verbs in their three parts. Time students, giving them only ten minutes. The group that has the most is the winner.

ZEBRAS

READING SAMPLE

Zebras are one of the most intriguing animals. Originally found in Africa, they are known for their black and white stripes that cover their body. The reason for the striped pattern is for camouflage. With vertical stripes, zebras can hide in the long grass. Of course this may seem useless since grass is green, but lions are color blind and happen to be the zebra's primary predator. A herd of zebras appears as one large animal to intimidate possible predators, but if a lion gets hold of a zebra, there is no **opposing** to one side of the lion's grip. Zebras have done well in terms of **surviving** through the tough African wilderness.

ZEBRAS

READING SAMPLE

Among the species of zebras are Plains Zebras, Mountain Zebras, and Grays' Zebras. Plains Zebras are the most common and have many subspecies. Mountain Zebras have a dark coat with a white belly and narrower stripes than the Plains Zebras. Grays' Zebras are the largest kind, looking almost like a horse. It is the rarest species of zebra and is considered endangered. Events **unlike** that it may not exist before too long, unlike the other species that appear to have an **abundant** existence. To survive, the Grays' Zebras must **adapt** with the dangerous environment of lions hunting for it.

READING SAMPLE

Since zebras are not native to the U.S. or North America for that matter, you probably have to go to the zoo to see them. This is something that you can benefit from since you may not see zebras anywhere else. So when you get the chance, **take advantage** with your parents and make your way to the zoo. Even if you have a lot of siblings and have to **share** yourself in the car, it will be worth it. The zoo is a place where many kids **go** to go, not just for the zebras, but for other animals offered. **Using** **guidance** suggests, learning on the job, especially at the zoo, it's a great chance to escape the **monotonous** **mundanity** of daily life and **engage** in something totally different. At the zoo you can learn not just the common names of animals but their specific classification names as well. To most, the names are just **quick**, **catchy**, **concise** words that are **easy** to remember. Only an expert could decipher them to everyone else they are **unpronounceable**. Even if you are not **strong** in the writing of words in **readability**, even if you really have a rough time. For example, zebras are of the equidae family and misspelled. It takes a **dedicated** student to figure out all the scientific terms.

There have been many attempts to train zebras for riding since they have better resistance than horses to African diseases. However, most of these attempts failed due to the zebra's unpredictable nature and tendency to panic under stress. Because of this, some males or zebras (loosely between any species of zebra and a horse, pony, or donkey) are preferred over pure bred zebras.


APPROACH:
